The ADS has established trial gardens in various regions of the country for dahlia promotion, evaluation, and scoring of undissemated cultivars. For cultivars that achieve a score of 85 or more in three or more trial gardens a medal is awarded to those having the highest average trial garden score in each category. These dahlias will be introduced as new varieties for 2014 with the added designation of being medal winners.
